Statement of Faith

We believe in the Holy Spirit, of one substance, power, and glory, with the Father and the Son, eternal God. We believe the Holy Spirit fills responsive believers, empowering the same to manifest the "works that Jesus did and greater works than these". (John 14:12)

We understand that man was created good and upright, for God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness" (Genesis 1:26) However, man, by voluntary transgression, sinned and thereby incurred not only physical death, but also spiritual death, which is separation from God. Man's only hope of redemption is through the shed blood of Jesus Christ, the Son of God. Salvation is received through repentance toward God and faith on the Lord Jesus Christ.

We believe God is faithful to forgive man's confessed sins and to cleanse the believer from all sin through the Blood of Jesus Christ. In a first step of obedience, believers are to be baptized in water as a sign of profession of faith.

We believe that divine healing is the will of God for man and that "the prayer of faith shall save the sick." (James 5:15)

We believe Christians are part of the ministry for reaching the world for Christ.

We believe that two Sacraments are ordained of Jesus Christ in the Gospel, Holy Baptism and Holy Communion known as the Lord's Supper.
